



Ride Smart CD Conditions of Entry

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Conditions of Entry.
2. Entry is only open to permanent residents of Victoria aged 18 years and over holding a current Victorian motorcycle learner's permit or licence at the time of entry. Employees and management of the Promoter and their immediate families are ineligible to enter. Individual employees, contractors and management of companies, agencies and suppliers associated with this Promotion are ineligible to enter if those individuals are directly associated with the Promotion.
3. The Promotion commences on 31 January 2012 and ends on 30 July 2012.
4. To participate in the Promotion, entrants must order the Ride Smart CD-ROM, complete the Ride Smart training and then register that they have completed the training by completing the online registration form or mailing a printed copy of it to the Promoter.
5. Entrants will be entered into a draw to win one of four \$200 vouchers for motorcycle protective clothing. A draw to determine the four winners for that draw will be conducted on each of the following dates: 30 April 2012 and 30 July 2012 at 60 Brougham Street, Geelong, Victoria. Participants are eligible for one draw only. Entries for each draw close at 5pm on the Friday before that draw. The four winners for each draw will be notified by certified mail.
6. Only one entry per person is permitted. Any entries containing incorrect contact details will be deemed invalid. The Promoter reserves the right to verify the validity of entries. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost or misdirected entries.
7. Total prize pool is valued at A\$1,600. Vouchers are not transferable and cannot be taken as cash. Vouchers are issued subject to any conditions of the store from which the voucher is issued.

The Promoter is not liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) or for personal injury suffered or sustained as a result of participating in the Promotion or accepting and using any of the prizes, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law.

The Promoter collects entrants' personal information and may disclose it to its marketing and promotional agencies, information technology providers and database service providers in order to conduct and evaluate the Promotion (including to confirm that the entrant holds a valid motorcycle permit or licence) and to send the entrant further information about TAC safety initiatives (if the entrant has opted to receive such information from the Promoter when they provided their details to the Promoter).
