Conditions of Entry

By entering this competition, you accept these terms and conditions:

1. The competition will start at 8am on Friday 20 August 2010. To enter, all you have to do is complete the online entry form located at www.spokes.com.au and detail (in 150 words or less) your motorcycle safety riding tips and hints. You must submit the online entry form, before 5pm on Monday 20 September 2010, via the website www.spokes.com.au.
2. An expert panel of motorcyclists and road safety experts, as chosen by the TAC, will review every entry form and short list 10 entries that they judge to be the most interesting motorcycle safety riding tips and hints and most likely to make the biggest difference to motorcycle safety. Chance plays no part in determining the winner.
3. You agree that if your entry is one of the short listed entries, as a condition of your prize, you will be available and will attend a Melbourne location, as determined by the TAC, between 1.30pm and 4.30pm on Saturday 2 October 2010, and agree to be filmed stating the motorcycle safety riding tips and hints that you submitted in your entry.
4. You agree to assign to the TAC all of your intellectual property rights (including copyright) in the material submitted to the TAC for the purposes of or in connection with this competition (including the motorcycle safety riding tips and hints, and your filmed image, voice, or physical likeness), in consideration of your prize. You warrant that the entry is your own original work.
5. Of the 10 short listed entries, the expert panel will select one entry that is considered to detail the best and/or most interesting motorcycle safety riding tips and hints. If you submitted that entry, you will receive the Ultimate 2010 IVECO Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix Experience. The remaining 9 short listed entries will receive a double pass to the 2010 IVECO Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix at Phillip Island for 15 October 2010 to 17 October 2010 (3 days) and a pair of Alpinestars leather gloves valued at \$79.95 each. Each 2010 IVECO Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix double pass is valued at \$265 (total value is \$530).
6. If you are the winner of the Ultimate 2010 IVECO Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix Experience, you and a friend of your choice will receive a Grandstand ticket to the 2010 IVECO Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix at Phillip Island for 15 October 2010 to 17 October 2010 (3 days), a helicopter ride over the Phillip Island Grand Prix Race Circuit, a guest lap of the Phillip Island Grand Prix Race Circuit in the Course Car, and a H.A.R.T. rider training course. The Ultimate 2010 IVECO Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix Experience is valued at \$2,020.
7. No prize is exchangeable or redeemable for cash.

8. You are only eligible to enter the competition if you are a resident of Victoria and are not an employee, or related to an employee, of the TAC or one of its agents connected with this competition.

You consent to the TAC providing your name and date of birth detailed on your entry form to VicRoads (or the equivalent regulator in any Australian state or territory) so VicRoads can verify your age and driving history for the purpose of confirming to the TAC that you are eligible to enter this competition.
10. If your entry is short-listed or you win the Ultimate 2010 IVECO Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix Experience, the TAC will contact you by telephone and/or email. You agree that your name may be published on the website: www.spokes.com.au.

If you receive the Ultimate 2010 IVECO Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix Experience, you and your chosen friend must follow the instructions of the TAC's representative and race officials and the Australian Grand Prix Corporation (**AGPC**) and must not consume any alcohol or any illegal substances before the helicopter ride, the guest lap, or the training course. You and your chosen friend must each produce identification in a form acceptable to the TAC's representative before you receive the prize. You acknowledge and agree that the helicopter ride, the guest lap, and the training course may be cancelled or delayed due to weather or other conditions, at the direction of the pilot, the driver, race officials, AGPC or if the 2010 IVECO Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix is delayed, suspended or cancelled and that this is beyond the control of the TAC. You and your chosen friend may be required to sign an indemnity and waiver of liability in a form approved by AGPC prior to participation in the prize, and you and your chosen friend acknowledge and agree that you may not be permitted to participate in the prize without satisfactorily completing the indemnity and waiver of liability.

accident causing injury, death or property damage or loss and my participation in the prize and attendance at the 2010 IVECO Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix is at my own risk.
